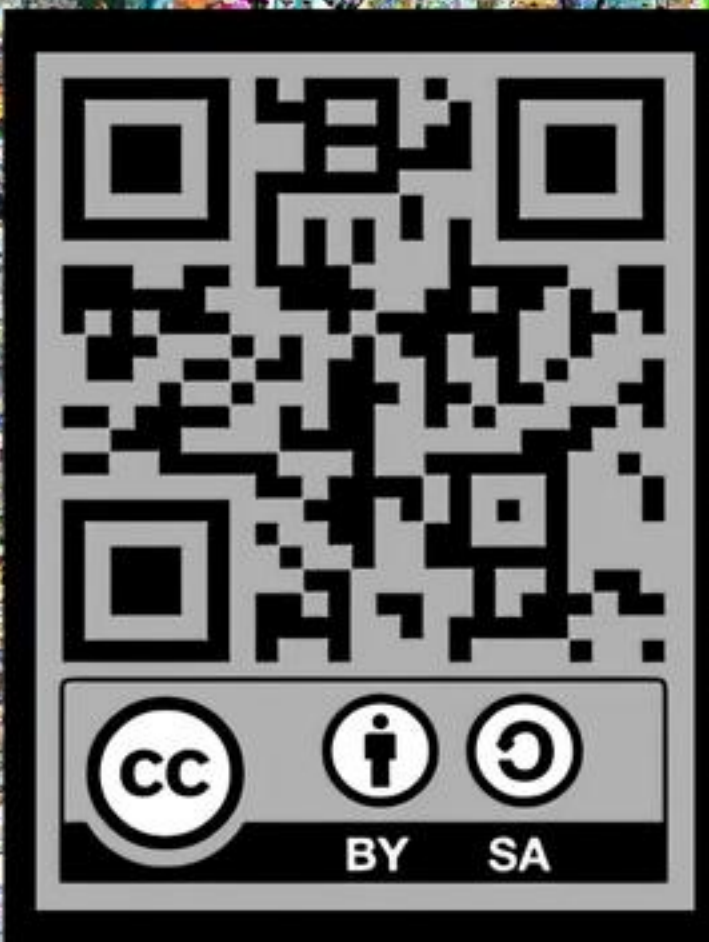
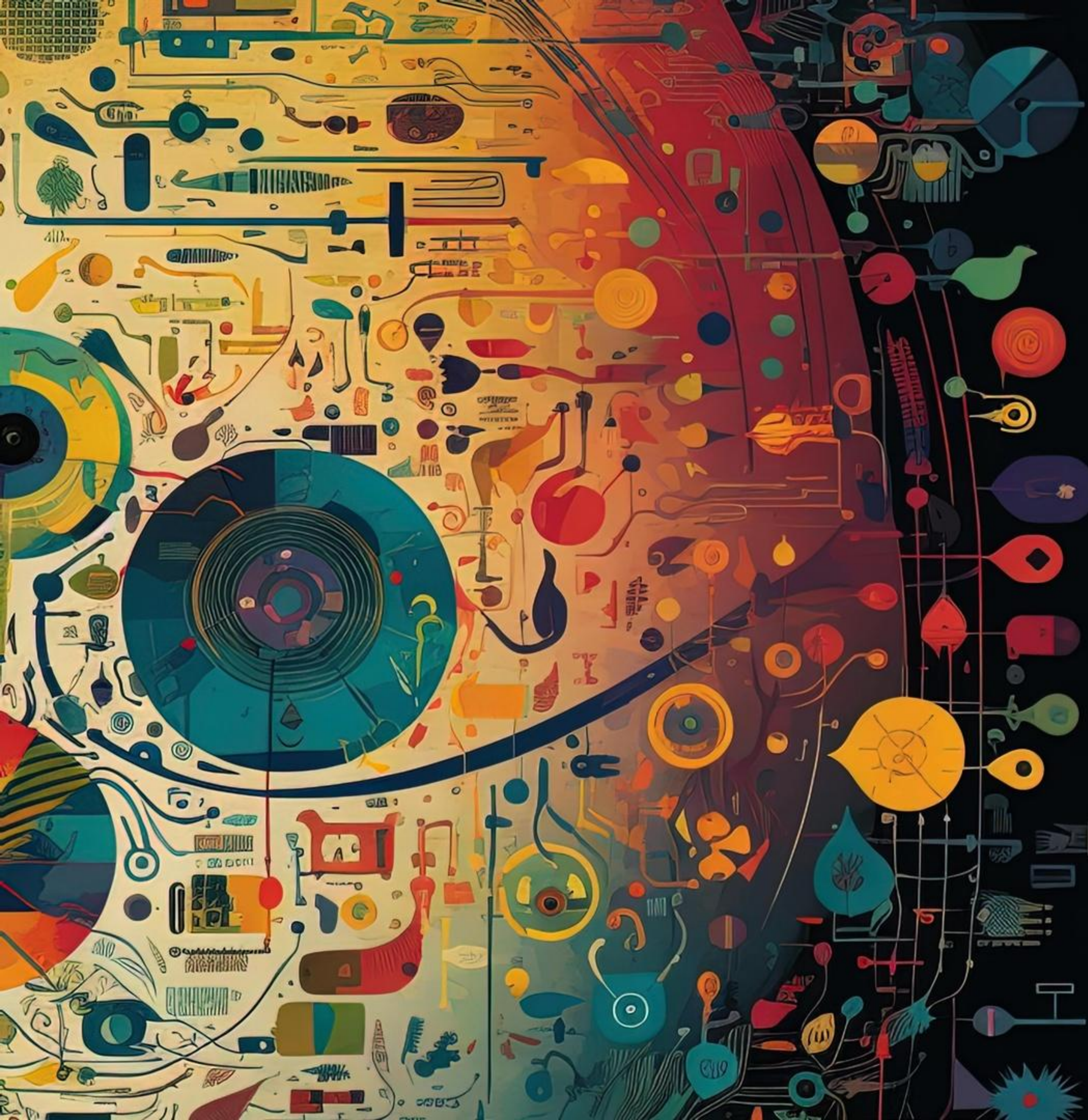

I am unique, and that's just fine



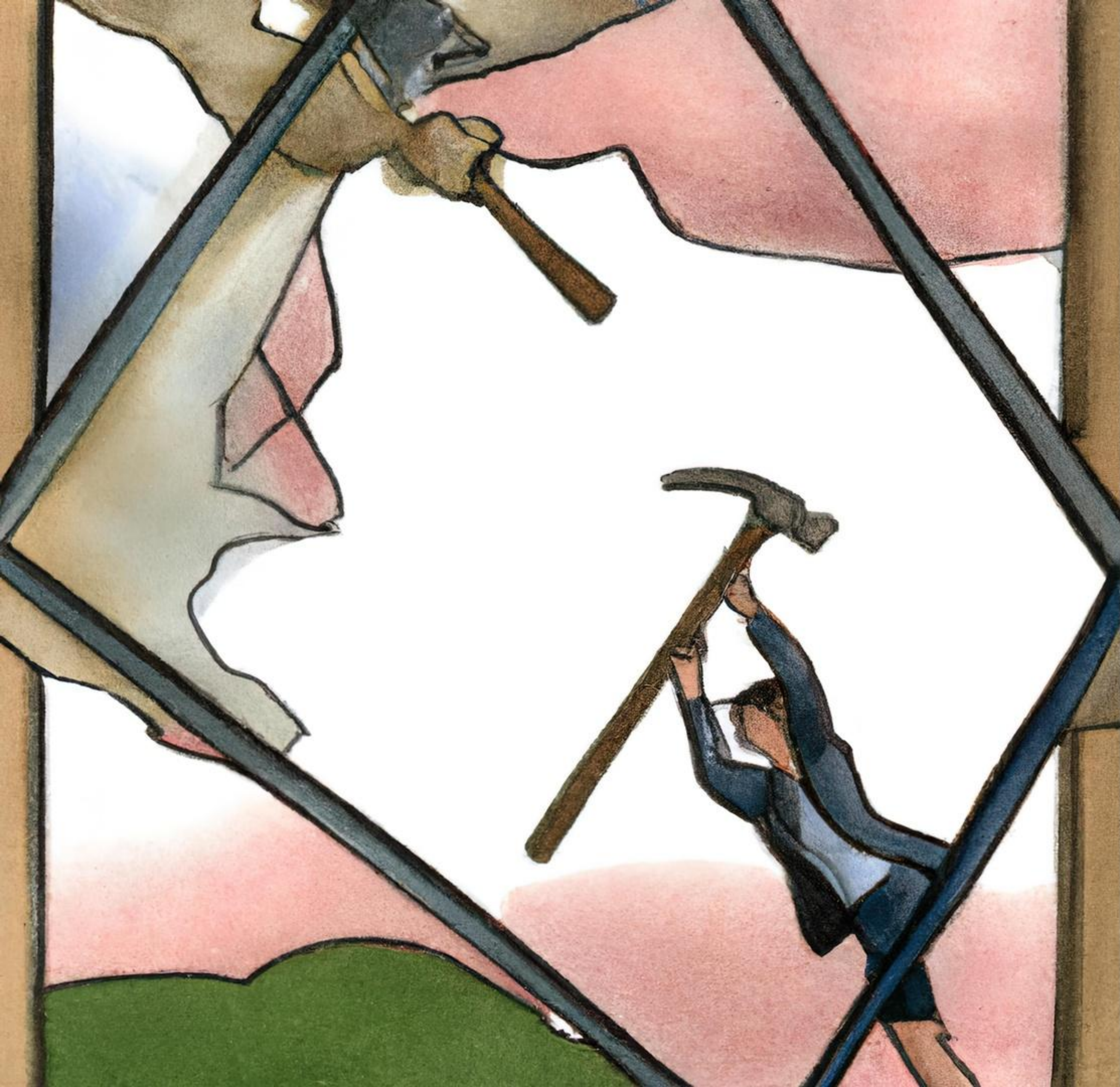
Chorus 2
