





Limited Effects Theory

Limited Effects Theory suggests that media only have a minor influence on people's opinions, attitudes, and behaviors. This theory argues that individuals have selective exposure to media content, and they tend to choose media messages that confirm their pre-existing beliefs and values. Mass media, in turn, reinforces and amplifies these pre-existing opinions and attitudes but does not radically change them. Limited Effects Theory also suggests that interpersonal communication and social networks are more influential than media in shaping individual attitudes and behaviors.
