




Media Dependency Theory


We're consumed by screens both big and small Always needing more, we can't break the fall What's the hold it has on our tired eyes? Why can't we say no to this digital guise?



Checking emails on our phones in bed Insta-scrolling until eyes turn red Notifications pop up every second Seems like our attention span has lessened




The TV's on all day and night

Why do we let it lead us astray?




It's a constant need, can't unplug the need

Chorus 2 We're always in reach of a screen Media dependency, what does it mean? It's taking over, a digital crater Why can't we break from this media dictator?




The radio's always playing a tune Sometimes it feels like a necessary boon But even they know how to manipulate The media's hold, it's not too late.
